In the spirit of anti-oppression we make every effort to create an affirming and nurturing environment within which it is expected that participants, volunteers and staff treat each other with respect and dignity. We do not tolerate any sexist, racist, and trans/homophobic language/ behaviors. Any violation will result in progressive consequences, assessed by ACO staff on a case by case basis.

In order to do so, each of us needs to be an active agent in this ongoing process; Following is a list of Rights and Responsibilities to guide us in this practice.
