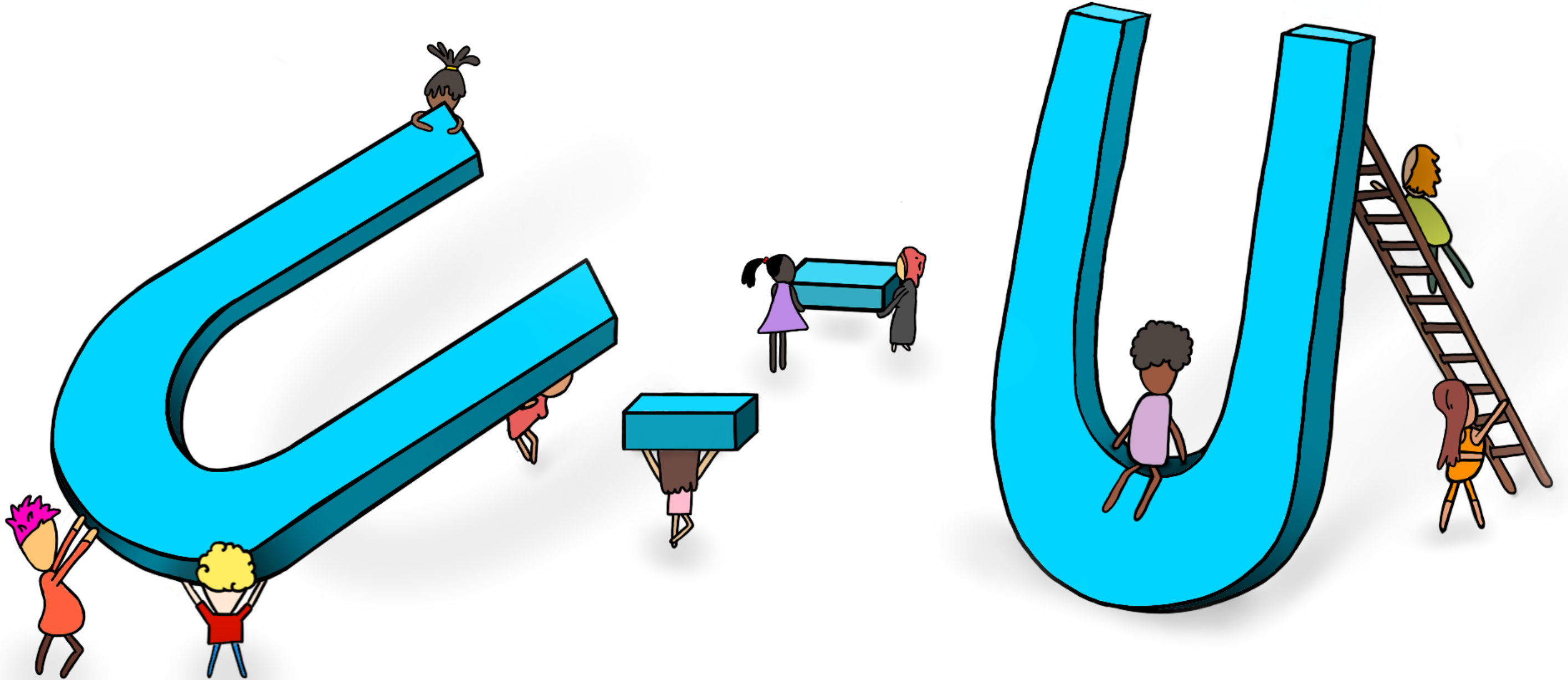

Bob Leahy is the lead Canadian representative for the U=U campaign. He is also publisher of PositiveLite.com, Canada's award-winning HIV Online magazine.



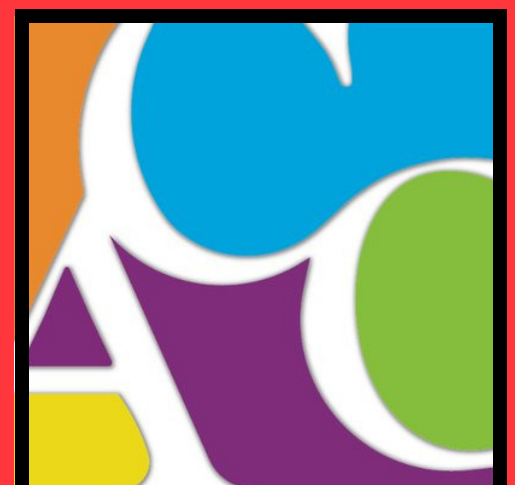
Bryan C. Jones has been thriving with HIV for over 34 years. He is one of the founding steering committee members of the U=U campaign.
